



## Uow Credit Recognition Agreement Expands

The Times Education Group is very pleased to announce that after successful partnerships with IIBT and TA English courses, the University of Wollongong is expanding their credit recognition to more of our courses and graduates.

The University of Wollongong (UOW) has become a benchmark for Australia's new generation of universities. It is ranked among the top modern universities in the world and has built a reputation as an enterprising institution, with a multi-disciplinary approach to research and a personalised approach to teaching.
