- Costs associated with optional free-time activities.
- Students are responsible for any additional expenses incurred at the hotel beyond room charges.
- Costs for accompanying guardian (chaperone) within the country.

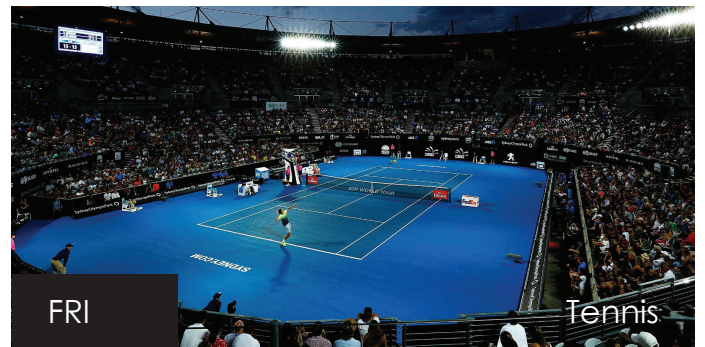

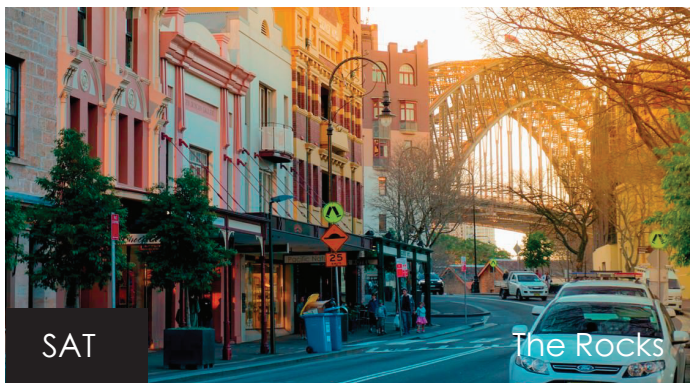

Afternoon: Take a ferry ride to explore Manly Beach (beach volleyball/team-building activities/swimming).

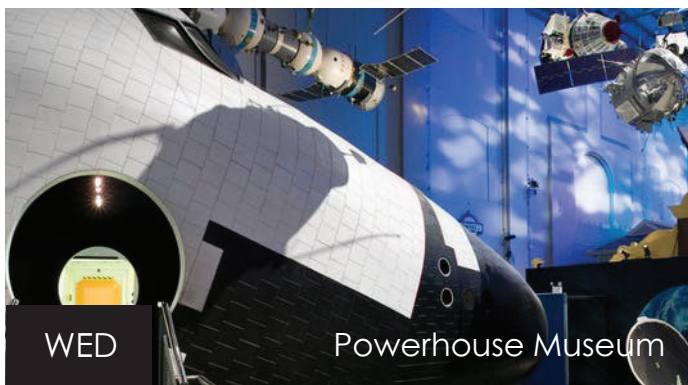

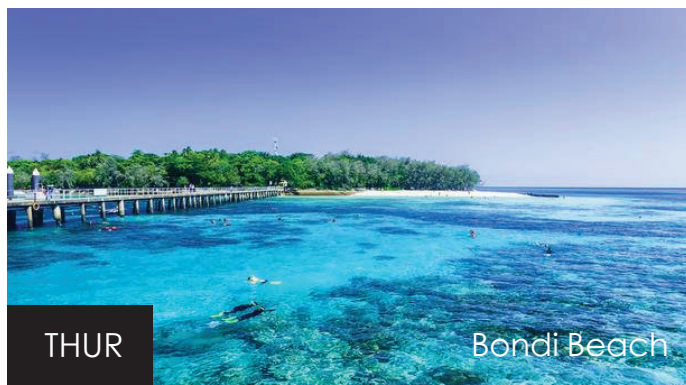

Sydney Snow Resort (Three days, two nights tour)

Every June, when the Sun's rays shine directly on the Tropic of Cancer, winter arrives in the southern hemisphere! In Australia's winter, one activity that should not be missed is skiing! Perisher Ski Resort is the largest ski resort in Australia, located about a 5-hour drive from Sydney. Skiing groups typically consist of 10 people, but the formation of groups depends on snow conditions, hotel capacity, and actual play dates, so ski group confirmations can only be made 7 days prior to the itinerary.

Important notes:

Mid-term Withdrawal:

- Students are required to comply with the instructions of the local group leader and the rules of the study tour. In the event of serious violations of the rules, the guardian and the school reserve the right to terminate the student's participation in activities and courses and order an early return home. Any fees already paid will not be refunded. The student will be responsible for all additional expenses incurred as a result of withdrawal, and the school and relevant parties reserve the right to seek compensation for any losses or liabilities caused by the student's withdrawal.
- Damage to property or accommodation facilities must be compensated at cost.
- Students under 18 years of age are not permitted to leave the accommodation or engage in independent activities without the consent of the guardian or the school.

Other Matters:

- Students must be at least 7 years old.
- Students must have overseas travel insurance.
- Students must have their application forms filled out by themselves and/or their parents, and must sign the form after reading the study tour safety instructions and declaration.
- Students must provide the required documents and ensure the authenticity of the materials and information provided.
- If a student fails to participate in the tour as scheduled or fails to board transportation on time as specified in the contract, it will be considered voluntary withdrawal and no refund will be given.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian for pick-up and drop-off.

Itinerary Matters:

- The itinerary provided for the courses and related information serves as a reference only. The final arrangement will be subject to the announcement made by the organizer.
- For the safety of the students, the organizer and the guardian have the right to prohibit students from participating in any optional or self-funded activities in the local area.
- In the event of unforeseen circumstances such as local strikes, political unrest, terrorist attacks, epidemics, typhoons, or natural disasters, which result in financial and time losses beyond human control, the organizer shall not be held responsible.
- The costs listed in the program are based on the exchange rates at the time of pricing. In the event of an increase in fuel prices or adjustments in foreign currencies due to fluctuations, the organizer reserves the right to adjust the costs before departure.
- Students must comply with customs regulations of each country. Those found carrying any prohibited items will be held responsible for their actions.
